### FLOATING LAND: ESCAPE MAKING

### 28 JUNE -27 JULY

Things have been getting a bit tense around here. Power and wealth are hugely concentrated. Heaps of people are finding it really hard to get by. Al is everywhere. We even shot Katy Perry into space. It all makes you feel like getting out of here – making an escape (perhaps à la Katy Perry).

Maybe it's worth weighing up options – floating some ideas around how we can get things back on track.

The Biennale *Floating Land* sees artists riffing off the social climate of the time. It puts art in public places to be encountered by people who don't usually seek it out. And it uses 'place' as part of its material and story.

One of the prevalent ideas from this year's *Floating Land: Escape Making* is that maybe we should stop putting ourselves at the centre of everything and give something else a go - like Fiona Harding who has been talking to the trees and transcribed the conversations - join her on a walking tour or listen to the trees onsite; Lisa Chandler and Donna Davis have installed *Retreet on Hastings* - a day spa for trees to thank them for the work they do; and Jamie North has brought his internationally acclaimed sculptural practice to Noosa.

There are around 15 projects, and many more workshops and events. Check it out via the QR code.
